But in the meantime, many of our visitor activities carry on during the winter. The Visitor Centre is used for birthday parties and the like, and our

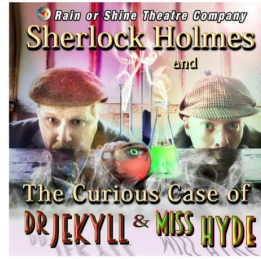


craft group meets regularly to participate in a wide variety of artistic and creative activities.
