WREN to the rescue!

We are delighted to announce that WREN (Waste Recycling Environmental Ltd) has awarded us a grant of £12,500 to fund some urgently needed work - re-pointing the brickwork to dry out and stabilise the mill building, replacing degraded electrical wiring in the mill, re-plumbing the visitor centre, and paving the area outside the centre.

There will still be some major projects outstanding - in particular, de-silting the mill pond and re-timbering the waterwheel. Further grant applications are in hand.
