This unique piece of furniture has been hand crafted by our volunteer Colin Wood, a retired cabinet maker. It could be used as a coffee table or bench.

The top is made from two of the old sole boards that were replaced on the water wheel last winter. The old elm wood is beautifully figured and distinctively stained by its contact with the iron bolts.



The dimensions are length 55 inches, width 15.25 inches and height 17.5 inches. The item can be inspected at the visitor centre whenever the mill is open - you really need to see and touch the top to appreciate its wonderful character.



The Trustees have decided to put the piece up for sale in aid of mill funds, with a reserve of £100, and invite sealed bids in excess of this figure.
